## PROFESSOR OF JAZZ: VOICE PERFORMANCE

Minimum Requirements: Master's degree in music with one of the following specialties: (1) Performance in Jazz Singing; (2) Performance in Classical Singing with a minor concentration in Latin Music studies (Latin Studies) or a minor concentration in Jazz studies (Jazz Studies); (3) Jazz Studies (Jazz Studies) with a major in Classical Singing. Minimum of five (5) years of experience teaching Jazz Singing and Latin music, preferably at the college level. Skills as a high-caliber performer. Professional experience as a performer in the area of Jazz Singing and Latin music. Spanish language proficiency. Full-time availability.

Nature of Work: University teaching work at the undergraduate and graduate levels that consists of individualized teaching and group seminars to students of Jazz Singing, offering orientation and academic counseling to students of the Department of Jazz and Caribbean Music, participation in faculty work committees, juries for admission tests and final exams, student recruitment, faculty concerts, and student departmental concerts.

Nature of the Interview, Audition, and Demonstrative Class Process:

Candidates will be evaluated regarding compliance with the minimum requirements.

They must be prepared to present an interview, a musical audition (which includes sight reading and improvisation), and a demonstration class with a student provided by the Conservatory. Only those candidates who meet the minimum requirements as announced in this call will be invited to the interview, audition, and demonstration class process.

Additional requirements: Interested candidates must send a letter requesting the position, their updated curriculum vitae, one (1) official credit transcript from all the institutions in which they have studied, three (3) letters of recommendation, and a list of five references evidencing his work experience teaching Jazz Singing.
