Douglas Anderson School of the Arts (DA) in Jacksonville, Florida is seeking a highly qualified and ambitious individual to serve as Director of Jazz Studies for the band department for the 2025-2026 school year and beyond. The nationally recognized DA Band department currently provides unique opportunities for musical growth to 9th-12th grade students through two concert bands, two jazz ensembles, jazz combo, percussion ensemble, and chamber ensembles. The band program also collaborates regularly with other departments on campus providing support for musical theater, full symphonic orchestra, pit orchestra and other creative interdisciplinary partnerships.

The Director of Jazz Studies is responsible for the coordination of all aspects of the jazz component of the band program, as well as instruction and direction of the DA Jazz Ensemble II, and Jazz Combo. The ideal candidate will have demonstrated experience with high school and/or college bands at an exceptional level of achievement. Furthermore, we are seeking an individual who will uphold the DA Band philosophy of creating a holistic music experience for the students, with the concert ensembles as the cornerstone of the program. Applicants should additionally be well-versed in teaching basic individual and ensemble music fundamentals. Also requisite to this position is the ability to teach and demonstrate improvisation at both a rudimentary and advanced level. They will work with a supportive, experienced, and successful band faculty and booster organization.

Douglas Anderson School of the Arts is a tuition-free Duval County Public High School. Admittance to the school is through audition only. Students must maintain high artistic and academic standards throughout their time at DA.
